

COVID-19 Urgent Eyecare Service (CUES)

Due to covid-19, a **new urgent eyecare service** has been set up in Leeds called CUES.

The service is **free to access** and will be provided by optometrists in Leeds and is for all patients. CUES will be delivered over the phone or a video call; however, for more complex or severe cases, face-to-face appointments will be offered in the community or Leeds Teaching Hospitals NHS Trust.

If you have an urgent eye problem, like:

- a red eye
- sore / painful eye
- flashes or floaters – this could be small dark spots, squiggly lines, rings or cobwebs
- a sudden change in vision, or
- foreign bodies - an object in your eye that shouldn't be there, this could be a speck of dust, a wood chip, a metal shaving, an insect or a piece of glass.
