

Patient use of Pulse Oximeter for self-management

Purpose	This is an NHSE Mandated programme to enable Covid Positive patients to monitor their oxygen saturation levels at home to evaluate the impact on admissions and mortality for Covid positive patients who are self-monitoring oxygen saturation levels and early identification of silent hypoxia
Type of information Used	GP Practices issue pulse oximeters to patients in practice. The NHS number and current O2 saturation and is recorded within the Practice clinical system.
