- GP surgeries are proactively contacting patients to book appointments. Patients are kindly asked to not contact their GP surgery to arrange Covid-19 vaccine appointments.
- This offer is available to all patients aged 18 and over who are registered at: Priory Medical Centre, Armley Medical Centre, or Thornton Medical Centre.

About the Covid-19 vaccine:

- All people aged 18 and over are now eligible for the vaccination.
- If you are aged over 50, living with a long term condition or have a suppressed immune system, you are at increased risk from Covid. Vaccines can help prevent you becoming seriously ill.
- The vaccines are safe and have been through rigorous checks, as well as extensive trials.
- Each vaccine requires two doses, 8 weeks apart (or sooner for people with health conditions that make them more vulnerable). The 1st dose gives you good protection from 3 or 4 weeks after having it. Having the second dose gives you stronger and longer-lasting protection.
- Having a vaccination is the best way to protect yourself, your family and your community from serious illness.
